A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST.
JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE TERMS, PROVISIONS,
CONDITIONS, AND REQUIREMENTS OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE STATE OF FLORIDA, AGENCY FOR HEALTHCARE
ADMINISTRATION, AND ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND
AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO
EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY

WHEREAS, utilizing funds from St. Johns County, Florida, in an amount not to exceed two hundred and eighty-three thousand, nine hundred and forty-three dollars (\$283,943.00) annually, along with additional funds from the State of Florida, Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) are to be disbursed to Flagler Hospital from AHCA for the purpose of providing the Low Income Pool (LIP) Hospital Program which is designed to compensate hospitals who provide disproportionate share of Medicaid and/or charity care services; and

WHEREAS, an Agreement between the State of Florida, Agency for Healthcare Administration, and St. Johns County, Florida, (attached and incorporated as Exhibit "A") provides the means for disbursing the state and federal grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions, and requirements of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that accepting the terms of the Agreement, and entering into said Agreement will serve the interests of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above Recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution, and are adopted as Findings of Fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the terms, provisions, conditions, and requirements of the Agreement between the State of Florida, Agency for Healthcare Administration, and St. Johns County, Florida, for the Low Income Pool Program and authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County.

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or content of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

## **Letter of Agreement**

	THIS LETTER OF AGREEMENT made and entered into in duplicate on the	day	
of	2009, by and between St. Johns County (the County), and the State of Florida,		
through its Agency for Health Care Administration (the Agency),			

- 1. Per Senate Bill 2600, the General Appropriations Act of State Fiscal Year 2009-2010, passed by the 2009 Florida Legislature, County and the Agency, agree that County will remit to the State an amount not to exceed a grand total of \$283,943.
  - a) The County and the Agency have agreed that these funds will only be used to increase the provision of health services for the Medicaid, uninsured, and underinsured people of the County and the State of Florida at large.
  - b) The increased provision of Medicaid, uninsured, and underinsured funded health services will be accomplished through the following Medicaid programs:
    - i. The Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) program.
    - ii. The removal of inpatient and outpatient reimbursement ceilings for teaching, specialty and community hospital education program hospitals.
    - iii. The removal of inpatient and outpatient reimbursement ceilings for hospitals whose charity care and Medicaid days as a percentage of total adjusted hospital days equals or exceeds 11 percent.
    - iv. The removal of inpatient and outpatient reimbursement ceilings for hospitals whose Medicaid days, as a percentage of total hospital days, exceed 7.3 percent, and are trauma centers.
    - v. Increase the annual cap on outpatient services for adults from \$500 to \$1,500.
    - vi. Medicaid Low Income Pool (LIP) payments to rural hospitals, trauma centers, specialty pediatric hospitals, primary care services and other Medicaid participating safety-net hospitals.
    - vii. Medicaid LIP payments to hospitals in the approved appropriations categories.
    - viii. Medicaid LIP payments to Federally Qualified Health Centers.
    - ix. Medicaid LIP payments to Provider Access Systems (PAS) for Medicaid and the uninsured in rural areas.
    - x. Medicaid LIP payments for the expansion of primary care services to low income, uninsured individuals.

- 2. The County will pay the State an amount not to exceed the grand total amount of \$283,943. The County will transfer payments to the State in the following manner:
  - a) The first quarterly payment of \$70,988 for the months of July, August, and September is due upon notification by the Agency.
  - b) Each successive payment of \$70,985 is due no later than, December 31, 2009, March 31, 2010 and June 15, 2010.
  - c) The State will bill the County each quarter payments are due.
- 3. Attached are the DSH and LIP schedules reflecting the anticipated annual distributions for State Fiscal Year 2009-2010.
- 4. The County and the State agree that the State will maintain necessary records and supporting documentation applicable to Medicaid, uninsured, and underinsured health services covered by this Letter of Agreement. Further, the County and State agree that the County shall have access to these records and the supporting documentation by requesting the same from the State.
- 5. The County and the State agree that any modifications to this Letter of Agreement shall be in the same form, namely the exchange of signed copies of a revised Letter of Agreement.
- 6. The County confirms that there are no pre-arranged agreements (contractual or otherwise) between the respective counties, taxing districts, and/or the providers to re-direct any portion of these aforementioned Medicaid supplemental payments in order to satisfy non-Medicaid, non-uninsured, and non-underinsured activities.
- 7. The County agrees the following provision shall be included in any agreements between the County and local providers where funding is provided for the Medicaid program. Funding provided in this agreement shall be prioritized so that designated funding shall first be used to fund the Medicaid program (including LIP) and used secondarily for other purposes.
- 8. This Letter of Agreement covers the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
