

RESOLUTION 2010 - 111

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 GENERAL FUND TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the County operating budget is annually prepared prior to knowing grant monies which may be received by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2010, did not anticipate receiving extra monies from the Audubon/Toyota TogetherGreen Fellows program in Washington D.C.; and

WHEREAS, Amy Gilboy Meide, Land Management Coordinator, was awarded the Mentor Award of \$1,000 through the alliance of Audubon and Toyota to put towards her conservation action project within St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Environmental Division needs their recognition as current year revenues to enable the appropriation of these funds for their intended purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact.
2. The General Fund revenue and the Environmental Division expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds in the amount of \$1,000.00 from the National Audubon Society.
