JOHNS COUNTY AND PROCURE SERVICES FROM A QUALIFIED FIRM(S) OR INDIVIDUAL(S) TO ADMINISTER THE GRANT; PERMIT \$125,000 IN ANTICIPATED STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP (SHIP) FUNDS TO BE USED AS PROGRAM MATCH AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO EXECUTE THE APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Services Division seeks authorization to apply to the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for anticipated funding availability under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for Economic and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the importance of the CDBG program to serve the needs of our low income households; and

WHEREAS, the County Housing and Community Services Division requests authorization to procure the services required for administration if the anticipated funding is approved by the Department of Community Affairs; and

WHEREAS, community matching funds up to a maximum amount of \$125,000 are one of the scoring criteria for CDBG funding applications which has been in the form of State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) program funds for St. Johns County in the past, resulting in funding being awarded to St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, in the event St. Johns County receives a sufficient FY 2010/2011 allocation of SHIP funds, then up to \$125,000 will be made available to be used as program match for CDBG funding; and

WHEREAS, should St. Johns County fail to be receive sufficient FY 2010/2011 SHIP funding, , then no program match will be indicated or provided for CDBG funding application; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of funding being awarded to St. Johns County by the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for Economic and Community Development, a separate request for proposal for administration of the grant would be prepared in accordance with approved County Purchasing policy; and

WHEREAS, pursuing such a strategy is in the long-term interests of the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the use of \$125,000 in FY 2010/2011 State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funds, should an allocation be received by St. Johns County, as program match in the submittal of an application for Small Cities CDBG Program funds on behalf of St. Johns County, Florida, and authorizes the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners to sign the application for submission to the Department of Community Affairs.
- **Section 3.** The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County to procure the services of one or more firms or individuals, in order to assist the County with administration of a Small Cities CDBG grant if the application is successful.
- **Section 4.** To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without the subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
