A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD CHAIR TO EXECUTE THE PHOSPHATE, MINERALS, METALS AND PETROLEUM RESERVATIONS AND RELEASE OF RELATED RIGHTS OF ENTRY AND EXPLORATION DOCUMENT, ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD, IN CONNECTION WITH PROPERTIES THAT HAVE BEEN CONVEYED TO THE HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statute Section 270.11(3) there has been a written request from the Housing Finance Authority of St. Johns County, ("HFA") attached hereto as Exhibit "A", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof, to release the mineral reservations that are normally reserved in all County Deeds; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2010-82 authorized conveyance of certain property to the Housing Finance Authority of St. Johns County by County Deed for affordable housing purposes and the "HFA" requests that the mineral reservations within the County deed be released; and

WHEREAS, said mineral reservations, and in particular the right to mine and develop, is a cloud on the title to the property which could prevent owners of the affordable housing property from obtaining financing for the property; and

WHEREAS, the execution of a Release of Phosphate, Minerals, Metals and Petroleum Reservations and Release of Related Rights of Entry and Exploration document, attached hereto as Exhibit "B", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof, would remove the cloud on the title; and

WHEREAS, to the extent that there are typographical, scriveners or administrative errors that <u>do not</u> change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the form of Release of Phosphate, Minerals, Metals and Petroleum Reservations and Release of

Related Rights of Entry and Exploration and authorizes the Board Chair to execute the Release.

Section 3. The Clerk of Court is instructed to record the original Release of Phosphate, Minerals, Metals and Petroleum Reservations and Release of Related Rights of Entry and Exploration in the Public Records of St. Johns County, Florida.
