RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 140

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT PER THE TERMS OF A STIPULATED FINAL ORDER IN AN EMINENT DOMAIN CASE FOR ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY FOR THE FOUR MILE ROAD/VOLUSIA STREET ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2009, per Chapter 127, Florida Statutes, the Board approved Resolution 2009-238 authorizing eminent domain for property needed for the Four Mile Road/Volusia Street Roadway Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, as part of the eminent domain process mediation proceedings were held which resulted in a settlement agreement and Final Stipulated Order, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Final Stipulated Order provides for all inclusive compensation of \$315,000.00 for property, expert fees and attorney fees; and

WHEREAS, the parcel included in the Settlement Agreement is described as Parcel 103 on the attached Exhibit "B", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to approve the Final Stipulated Order to conclude this eminent domain case without additional court and expert fees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that:

- **Section 1.** The above Recitals are incorporated herein by reference and are hereby adopted as Findings in support of this Resolution.
- **Section 2.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the terms of the Final Stipulated Order, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein.

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

STIPULATED FINAL JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on the joint motion of petitioner St. Johns County (the "County") and defendants Kaushik and Maltiben Patel for entry of this Stipulated Final Judgment as to the eminent domain taking of the fee simple interest in the property described as Parcel 103 in Exhibit A (the "Property"), and the Court finding that the parties are authorized to enter into their joint motion, proper notice has been given to all persons having or claiming any equity, lien, title or other interest in or to the Property, and the compensation to be paid by the County is full, just and reasonable, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. The Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter and the parties to this cause pursuant to Chapter 73, Florida Statutes.

- 2. The pleadings in this cause are sufficient and the County is properly exercising its delegated authority to acquire the Property for the public purpose described in the Petition.
- 3. Kaushik and Maltiben Patel and their attorneys and experts do have and recover from the County the total sum of THREE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$315,000.00) as full compensation for the taking of the Property and in satisfaction of all damages, interest or other sums recoverable in this action, inclusive of all attorneys' fees, expert fees or costs, including all attorneys' fees and costs for any and all monetary and non-monetary benefits obtained.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of this judgment, the County shall deposit into the Registry of the Court the sum of ONE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$160,300.00) (the "Deposit"), which is the difference between the total amount of stipulated full compensation of THREE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$315,000.00) and the ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$154,700.00) the County previously deposited into the Registry of the Court pursuant to the Order of Taking in this action.
- 5. The Clerk of the Court is ordered and directed upon receipt of the Deposit, without further order of the Court, to disburse the sum of ONE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$160,300.00) as follows:
