A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD CHAIR TO EXECUTE A COUNTY DEED TO THE HOLY CHURCH OF ZION IN ORDER TO CLEAR THE CLOUD ON THE TITLE TO THE PROPERTY.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County is reviewing all unused County owned property that is suitable for sale to adjoining property owners. Upon review of the chain of title for certain County property located off Armstrong Road it was found that a tax deed was issued in 1946 to an individual and the County is shown as the property owner in error; and

WHEREAS, in order to clear the title of the property the Holy Church of Zion has requested that the property be transferred to the Church as shown on the letter attached hereto as Exhibit "A", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to convey any interest the County may have in the property to the adjacent property owner by the County Deed attached hereto as Exhibit "B", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof, to clear the cloud on the title. The Church has also requested that the mineral reservations be released as shown on the letter attached hereto as Exhibit "C", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, to the extent that there are typographical, scriveners or administrative errors that <u>do not</u> change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the Board Chair to execute said County Deed.
- 3. The Clerk of Circuit Court is hereby instructed to record the County Deed in the Public Records of St. Johns County, Florida.
