A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST.
JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SUBGRANT
AGREEMENT MODIFICATION EXTENSION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM FUNDS ON
BEHALF OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY

#### **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, The Housing and Economic Recovery Act (HERA) created the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) which is primarily intended for the acquisition of bank owned foreclosure properties which, once acquired, will be sold to income eligible households or used for very-low income rental housing; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the importance of the NSP program to serve the needs of our community and the benefits of the eligible uses of the funds in the NSP program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners per resolutions, 2008-330 AND 2009-67 AND 2009-211 approved submitting an application to the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) and authorized the execution of a Subgrant Agreement with DCA; and

WHEREAS, DCA requested that the County execute a one year extension in their correspondence dated June 9, 2011; and included for execution a Subgrant Agreement Modification Extension for one year commencing October 6, 2011 for contract 10DB-4X-04-65-01-F 22, a federally funded Subgrant Agreement for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program in the initial amount of \$2,489,344; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** To approve a Subgrant Agreement Modification Extension for one year commencing October 6, 2011 for DCA contract 10DB-4X-04-65-01-F 22 for Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) funding and authorize the Chairman to sign and Staff to submit to DCA.
- **SECTION 2.** REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any portion or section of this Resolution is determined to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall in no manner affect the remaining portions or sections of this Resolution which shall remain in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 4.** ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board.
- **SECTION 5**. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

#### Dear Chairman Sanchez:

As you know, your NSP-1 Subgrant Agreement was executed on October 6, 2009. Awards were made based on the Department's usual two year contract period with the knowledge that most, if not all, local governments would not be able to completely finish their projects within that time frame. As anticipated, the two year contract period was not enough time for the local governments to complete their NSP projects. At this time, the Department is initiating Subgrant Agreement Modifications for an additional year (one year from your current contract end date — October 5, 2011). This one-year extension should allow each local government ample time to substantially complete their projects, however, with program income adding activities to initial NSP projects, another extension may be needed.

In order to finalize the Subgrant Agreement extension, we need the following items from your local government within 45 days:

- A cover letter that contains a brief narrative on the overall status of your current program;
- o A Subgrant Agreement Modification form;
- O A revised Attachment A Budget (by strategy) if you need to make any budget adjustments at this time;
- o Please reflect any program income that you have on hand in the "other funds" column of Attachment A, and
- o A revised Attachment B Activity Work Plan based on the new end date of your contract.

Please note that three original Modification to Subgrant Agreement, Activity Work Plan and Budget (if revised) are needed. Once executed by the Department, an original will be returned to you.
