

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-303

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A COMPETITIVE APPLICATION FOR A RURAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES GRANT FOR \$150,000 PER YEAR, UP TO THREE YEARS.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, under the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration, Office of Rural Health Policy, Rural Health Care Services Outreach funds have been made available through a competitive grant application process; and,

WHEREAS, this program is authorized by Section 330A (e) of the Public Health Service Act to "promote rural health care services outreach by expanding the delivery of health care services to include new and enhanced services in rural areas"; and,

WHEREAS, the Outreach Program supports projects that demonstrate creative or effective models of outreach and service delivery in rural communities. Funding can be used to meet a broad range of health care needs from health promotion and disease prevention to expanding oral and mental health services to case management for rural HIV patients; and,

WHEREAS, these projects address the needs of a wide range of population groups including, but not limited to, low-income populations, the elderly, pregnant women, infants, adolescents, rural minority populations and rural populations with special health care needs. All projects are responsive to any unique cultural, social, religious and linguistic needs of the target population; and,

WHEREAS, these funds can be used to promote health/medical/dental care needs of the targeted rural areas of Hastings and West Augustine; and,

WHEREAS, no matching funds by the County are required; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Administrator, or his designee, to execute any other related documents and take any other actions necessary for the application of this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above Recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution, and are adopted as Findings of Fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is authorized to submit, on the County's behalf, an application for the Rural Health Care Services Outreach Grant as described above. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute the application and all supplemental documents necessary to apply for such grant funding.

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised, without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

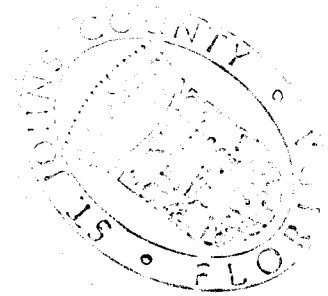

The Office of Rural Health Policy's Outreach Program supports projects that demonstrate effective models of outreach and service delivery through collaboration, adoption of an evidence-based or promising practice model, demonstration of health outcomes, replicability and sustainability. Proposed projects will have an outcomes-oriented approach that will enhance and sustain the delivery of effective health care in rural communities by tracking specific health indicators that will demonstrate the impact of their project at the end of their grant period. They will be based on evidence-based or promising practice models in order to avoid "reinventing the wheel" and demonstrate health status improvement in rural communities. Proposed Outreach projects can take the framework of an evidence-based or promising practice model and tailor it to their community's need and organization.
