

RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 330

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID NO. 11-98 AND TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIMEROCK BASE & STABILIZED BASE REQUIREMENTS FOR SJC ROAD & BRIDGE DEPARTMENT.**

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to enter into a contract with M.J. Stavola Industries, and MFM Limestone, Inc. to provide limerock base and stabilized base requirements on an as needed basis for the SJC Utility Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the scope of the project shall consist of supplying and delivering purchased limerock base and stabilized base requirements to the SJC Road & Bridge designated locations in St. Johns County; and

**WHEREAS**, through the County's formal bid process, M.J. Stavola Industries, and MFM Limestone, LLC were selected as the lowest, responsive, responsible bidders to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract is being funded by the SJC Road & Bridge Department;  
and

**WHEREAS**, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the Contract (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that entering into the Contract serves a public purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:**

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No. 11-98 to M.J. Stavola Industries ("Stavola") and MFM Limestone, LLC ("MFM").

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute the attached Contract with Stavola & MFM on behalf of the County for the supply of limerock base and stabilized base requirements as specifically provided in Bid No 11-98.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
