A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD <u>BID NO. 12-04</u> AND TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR <u>THE PURCHASE OF ALUMINUM SULFATE</u>.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with General Chemical Performance Products, LLC, and Thatcher Chemical of Florida, to provide aluminum sulfate to the SJC Utility Department on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the <u>project shall consist of supplying and delivering</u> <u>purchased aluminum sulfate to the SJC Utility Department designated locations in St. Johns County;</u> and

WHEREAS, through the County's formal bid process, General Chemical Performance Products, LLC, and Thatcher Chemical of Florida were selected as the lowest, responsive, responsible bidders to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the contract is being funded by the SJC Utility Department; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the Contract (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that entering into the Contract serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.
- Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No. 12-04 to General Chemical Performance Products, LLC ("General Chemical") and Thatcher Chemical of Florida ("Thatcher").
- Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute the attached Contract with <u>General Chemical & Thatcher</u> on behalf of the County for the supply of aluminum sulfate as specifically provided in Bid No 12-04.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
