RESOLUTION 2011 - **89**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2011 UTILITY FUND BUDGET IN ORDER TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY UTILITY DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Utility vehicle # 1152 was involved in an auto accident through no fault of the county; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Utility vehicle # 1152 was declared a total loss; and

WHEREAS, Florida Farm Bureau Insurance Companies has paid \$11,050.20 as compensation for this loss; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Utilities needs to replace this vehicle; and

WHEREAS, these revenues were not anticipated during the preparation of the 2011 Fiscal Year Budget; and

WHEREAS, the recognition of these funds as current year revenues is required to enable their appropriation so as to replace St. Johns County Utility vehicle # 1152;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.
- 2. The Utility Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds from Florida Farm Bureau Insurance Companies in the amount of \$11,050.20 for Fiscal Year 2011.
- 3. The St. Johns County Utility Department is authorized to use and expend such funds for the purposes expressed in this Resolution.
- 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
