

RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 124

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID NO. 12-46 AND TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR SIGNALIZATION IMPROVEMENTS AT COASTAL HIGHWAY & SR A1A.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Traffic Control Devices, Inc. to provide services for Signalization Improvements at Coastal Highway & SR A1A; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the project shall generally include furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and other items necessary for removal and replacement of existing signal system and total turnkey installation; and

WHEREAS, through the County's formal bid process, Traffic Control Devices, Inc. was selected as the most qualified respondent to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the project is being funded through Impact Fees "B" (1188-55304-1208-56301) and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the Contract (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that entering into the Contract serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No. 12-46 Signalization Improvements at Coastal Highway & SR A1A to Traffic Control Devices, Inc.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute the attached Contract with Traffic Control Devices, Inc. on behalf of the County for the completion of the Signalization Improvements at Coastal Highway & SR A1A specifically provided in Bid No 12-46.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
