A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, FINDING A PUBLIC PURPOSE FOR AND AUTHORIZING AN OFFSET OF A PORTION OF THE IMACT FEES REQUIRED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HOME FOR JOHN HAYES, A SERVERLY DISABLED U.S. MARINE INJURED IN COMBAT.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Homes For Our Troops, a national non-profit organization is helping to finance the construction of a new home for John Hayes, a U.S. Marine who is now severely disabled as a result of military conflict; and

WHEREAS, Homes For Our Troops, previously constructed a home for Tyler Southern, a severely disabled combat Marine; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously approved assistance with the payment of a portion of the impact Fees for Tyler Southern in Resolution 2011-221; and

WHEREAS, there are Impact Fees required prior to the occupancy of a new home for John Hayes; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public and the County to recognize and promote service in the United States Armed Services and to express sincere appreciation for the sacrifices made by John Hayes for our Country.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, as follows;

- 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finding of fact.
- 2. To the extent that certain fees are established by the County, the County agrees to offset a portion of the Impact Fees associated with construction of the aforementioned new home estimated at \$6,016.
- 3. To the extent that there are scriveners, typographical or administrative errors that <u>do not</u> change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
