## RESOLUTION 2012 - 243

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012 TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY TOURIST DEVELOPMENT RECREATION DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida determined it was in the best interest of the citizens to construct a new beach access stairway at St. Augustine Beach adjacent to the St. Johns Ocean Pier; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, and the City of St. Augustine Beach, Florida agreed to share the cost of the construction of the beach access stairway; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing its budget for Fiscal Year 2012, did not anticipate receiving this contribution for the beach access stairway; and

WHEREAS, the contribution of \$9,000 is intended to be used to reimburse the County for 50% of the cost of the construction of the beach access stairway adjacent to the St. Johns Ocean Pier.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
- 2. The Board hereby recognizes the contribution of \$9,000 by the City of St. Augustine Beach as unanticipated revenue to reimburse the County for 50% of the cost of constructing the beach access stairway adjacent to the St. Johns Ocean Pier.
- 3. The County Administrator, or designee, shall allocate such funds to the Tourist Development Fund for use consistent with the provisions set forth in this Resolution.
- 4. To the extent that there are typographical or scrivener's errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor or concept of this Resolution, the County Administrator or designee is authorized to correct such errors without subsequent approval by the Board.
