A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012 UTILITY FUND BUDGET IN ORDER TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY UTILITY DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Utility vehicle # 177 was involved in an auto accident through no fault of the county; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Utility vehicle # 177 had damages; and

WHEREAS, Auto-Owners Insurance has paid \$1,549.72 as compensation for damages; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Utilities needs to repair this vehicle; and

WHEREAS, these revenues were not anticipated during the preparation of the 2012 Fiscal Year Budget; and

WHEREAS, the recognition of these funds as current year revenues is required to enable their appropriation so as to repair St. Johns County Utility vehicle # 177;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals

The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.

Section 2. Authority to Approve

The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves amending the Fiscal Year 2012 Utility Fund to receive unanticipated revenue and authorize its expenditure by Utility Services.

Section 3. Correction of Errors

Section 4. Effective Date
