

RESOLUTION NO. 2013- 10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN IMPACT FEE CREDIT AGREEMENT WITH St. Augustine Associates, Inc.

WHEREAS, St. Augustine Associates, Inc. is the Developer of certain lands contained within the St. Augustine Centre (the Project) as described and approved in St. Johns County Resolution No. 97-77 as amended; and

WHEREAS, Section 13 of St. Johns County Ordinance No. 87-57, as amended, St. Johns County Road Impact Fee Ordinance allows for impact fee credits to be granted by the Board of County Commissioners for the improvements made as identified within the Impact Fee Agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the County Road Impact Fee Ordinance, St. Augustine Associates, Inc. is entitled to certain impact fee credits for certain improvements.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that:

Section 1. The County Administrator is hereby authorized to approve and execute an Impact Fee Credit Agreement with St. Augustine Associates, Inc. substantially in the form of that which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for those improvements identified within the Road Impact Fee Ordinance which are eligible for impact fee credits.

Section 2. Upon acceptance by the County Administrator, the Clerk is instructed to record the agreement in the official records of St. Johns County, Florida.



**IMPACT FEE CREDIT AGREEMENT  
("AGREEMENT")**

**Road Impact Fees**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2013, by and among the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA** ("County") and **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.**

**RECITALS:**

- A. **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** is the Developer and projected Impact Feepayer of certain lands contained within the **St. Augustine Centre DRI** ("Project"), as described and approved in St. Johns County **Resolution No. 97-77, as amended.**
- B. Pursuant to St. Johns County **Ordinance No. 87-57**, as amended, ("**Road** Impact Fee Ordinance"), the County requires any person who seeks to develop land within St. Johns County, as evidenced by such person's application for a building permit or certificate of occupancy ("Feepayer"), to pay a **Road** impact fee, so as to assure that such new development bears a proportional share of the cost of capital expenses necessary to provide roads within St. Johns County.
- C. **Section 13B** of the **Road** Impact Fee Ordinance allows impact fee credits to be granted for certain **improvements** ("**Road** Impact Fee Credits").
- D. Pursuant to the County requirements of the Land Development Code **Section 13, St. Augustine Associates, Inc. has made improvements at the SR 16/McDonalds/BP Drive intersection**, which is recognized as meeting the requirements for **Road** Impact Fee Credits.
- E. Pursuant to the terms of the **Road** Impact Fee Ordinance, County and **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** desire to set forth their agreement and a procedure for the applicant and treatment of such **Road** Impact Fee Credits.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. The above stated Recitals are incorporated herein as Findings of Facts.
2. The total **Road** Impact Fee Credits will be calculated as the sum shown on **Exhibit A** in the **amount of \$194,253.32** (see attached **Exhibit A**).
3. **Method of Issuance.** From and after the date of the execution of this Agreement, so long as there is any balance remaining in the Impact Fee Credit Account, all Feepayers applying for building permits or certificates of occupancy in connection with any construction within the DRI, as may be amended from time to time, shall pay the amount due under the then-current Road Impact Fee Ordinance directly to St. Augustine Associates, Inc. St. Augustine Associates, Inc. shall be fully responsible for notifying all Feepayers of this requirement and shall ensure that such payments are directly paid to St. Augustine Associates, Inc. Then, for so long as the total Road Impact Fee Credits for which St. Augustine Associates, Inc.

has issued vouchers under this Agreement is less than the total Road Impact Fee Credits authorized by this Agreement, St. Augustine Associates, Inc. shall issue to such Feepayers a voucher evidencing full payment of the Road Impact Fees in connection with such Feepayer's application for a building permit or certificate of occupancy. The voucher issued by St. Augustine Associates, Inc. shall contain a statement setting forth the amount of Road Impact Fee paid and shall be in substantially the same form as set forth on the attached Exhibit D. Upon presentation of such voucher by the Feepayer, the County shall issue a receipt to the Feepayer and shall deduct the amount of such voucher from the Road Impact Fee Credit Account.

4. In the event that **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** determines to sell all or part of the Project, **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** may sell, transfer, assign or convey any of its interest in part of the **Road** Impact Fee Credits to such purchaser, transferee, assignee or grantee for use within the Project for such consideration as **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** in its sole discretion, determines. In such event, **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** shall execute and deliver to the County a copy of the instrument selling, transferring, assigning or granting the **Road** Impact Fee Credits so sold, transferred, assigned or granted and the remaining amount of **Road** Impact Fee Credits, if any, shall remain vested in **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.**. The Parties agree that no impact fee credit may be used or applied to development outside the Project without the specific approval of the County, and that such approval may be denied based on factors including, but not limited to the relationship of the **improvements** to the particular development to which credits are transferred. Developer acknowledges that only one Impact Fee Credit account may exist at any given time for the Development Property.
5. On or before January 31 of each year, so long as there remains any **Road** Impact Fee Credits, **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** shall prepare and deliver to the County Growth Management Department an annual report setting forth the amount of **Road** Impact fee payments made by the Feepayers applying for building permits or certificates of occupancy within the Project and the remaining balance of **Road** Impact Fee Credits.
6. At such time as the **Road** Impact Fee Credits provided for hereunder have been exhausted, **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** or the Feepayer seeking building permits or certificates of occupancy within the Project shall pay the County the **Road** Impact Fees as are then due and payable under the **Road** Impact Fee Ordinance in effect at that time.
7. Miscellaneous Provisions
  1. This Agreement shall be constructed and governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. All parties to this Agreement have participated fully in the negotiation and preparation hereof and accordingly, this Agreement shall not be more strictly construed against any one of the parties hereto. All parties agree particularly that this Agreement is bound by the terms of the County's **Road** Impact Fee Ordinance and other applicable ordinances. Any and all applicable terms of those Ordinances are to be considered incorporated herein by reference. If there is any inconsistency found between this Agreement and such Ordinances or applicable law, those Ordinances or law shall prevail and be applicable.
  2. The Parties agree that **Road** Impact Fee Ordinance **Section 13** limits the total amount of impact fee credits given to an amount not greater than the

total amount of impact fees due for the Project. The parties further agree that they will not challenge in any judicial proceeding and will accept the interpretation of the County Attorney's Office that the Road Impact Fee Credits identified or granted by this Agreement are limited to the amount of Impact Fees which are due or become due within the Development.

3. In construing the Agreement, the singular shall be held to include the plural, and the plural shall include the singular, the use of any gender shall include every other and all gender and captions and paragraph headings shall be disregarded.
  4. All of the exhibits attached to this Agreement are incorporated in, and made a part of this Agreement.
  5. The Agreement, and any Exhibits and/or addendum made a part hereof constitute the entire Agreement and understanding of the parties and shall not be modified or amended except by written agreement duly executed by the parties hereto.
  6. This Agreement is made for the sole benefit and protection of the parties and no other persons shall have any right of action hereunder. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns.
- 
7. All covenants, agreements, representation and warranties made herein shall be deemed to have material and relied on by each party to this Agreement.
  8. This agreement is recognized as being subject to the laws of Florida and the Ordinances of St. Johns County, Florida and therefore all applicable provisions thereof are incorporated herein and if any provision hereof is inconsistent with such provisions, such provision shall apply.
  9. **St. Augustine Associates, Inc.** must be a feepayer as referenced in the applicable impact fee ordinance to receive impact fee credits under this ordinance.
  10. Nothing in this Agreement shall act to allow an entity to receive impact fees credits for contributions provided by a government entity including, but not limited to, a Community Development District.
  11. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to require the County to continue to levy or collect Impact Fees, or, if levied, to levy them for any certain amount.



1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY MR. RICHARD REED AT ST. JOHNS COUNTY'S TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION (904) 208-0170 AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF INSTALLING SIGNAL HEADS, INSTALLING UNDERGROUND CONDUIT, SETTING POLES, SEALING SIGNAL HEAD ASSEMBLIES, CUTTING LOOPS, ETC., SO THAT THESE OPERATIONS MAY BE OBSERVED AT 50 FEET.

2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE UTILITY DEPARTMENT AT LEAST 24 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF HOLE SETTING OPERATIONS, WHERE CONFLICT WITH OVERHEAD ELECTRICAL CONDUITS IS EXPECTED AND IN ALL CASES WHERE JOINT USE POLES ARE CALLED FOR.

3. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT NO TEST BORDERS WERE MADE WHERE CONDUIT RUNS ARE TO BE INSTALLED BY JACKING OR TRENCHING. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENGINEER AND SET THE JOB SITE CONDITIONS BEFORE SUBMITTING PROPOSALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-4 OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.

5. ALL SIGNAL AND PEDESTRIAN INDICATORS SHALL HAVE LEDA DISPLAYS.

6. BEFORE MOST ARM POLES ARE ORDERED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CHECK THE ELEVATION OF ALL POLE FOUNDATIONS TO ENSURE ARMS ARE INSTALLED AT THE PROPER HEIGHTS. ST. JOHNS COUNTY WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY MOST ARM BASES THAT ARE BELOW GROUND LEVEL.

7. AT THE TIME OF FINAL PROJECT INSPECTION THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH THE TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION AND FOOT'S TRAFFIC OPERATIONS TO ST. JOHNS COUNTY WITH ONE COMPLETE SET OF AS-BUILT PLANS.

8. THE MINIMUM SIZE OF ANY NEW CONDUIT INSTALLED SHALL BE 2 INCHES EXCEPT AS ALLOWED AS FOLLOWS: A) NEW CONDUIT TO CONTAIN ELECTRICAL POWER SERVICE FROM THE ELECTRICAL SERVICE FEED POINT TO THE SERVICE DISCONNECT FROM THE SERVICE DISCONNECT TO THE CONTROLLER CABINET SHALL BE 1 1/2 INCHES (SEE MANUAL). B) CONDUIT CONTAINING GROUNDING WIRES SHALL BE 1 1/2 INCHES (SEE MANUAL). C) WHEN CONNECTING NEW POWER SERVICE CONDUIT TO EXISTING POWER SERVICE CONDUIT, THE MINIMUM SIZE AND TYPE OF CONDUIT SHALL BE USED.

9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY COLOR CODES FOR BOTH SIGNAL AND INTERCONNECT CABLE WITH ST. JOHNS COUNTY'S TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISION BEFORE ORDERING.

10. A MANUAL PUSHBUTTON CORD, TWO KEYS FOR THE CABINET AND ONE KEY FOR THE POLICE PANEL DOOR SHALL BE FURNISHED IN ALL CONTROLLER CABINETS.

11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTACTING THE COMPANY PROVIDING THE SIGNAL POWER TO DETERMINE IF A SERVICE PROCESSING FEE IS REQUIRED. IF REQUIRED, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INCLUDE AS PART OF PAYMENT FOR MATERIALS, LABOR AND SERVICE FEE SHALL BE INCLUDED AS PART OF PAYMENT FOR ELECTRICAL POWER SERVICE ASSEMBLY. 12. AS DIRECTED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADJUST CONDUIT TO AVOID ANY POSSIBLE CONFLICTS WITH UNDERGROUND UTILITIES.

13. ALL PULL BOX COVERS TO BE FURNISHED AND INSTALLED SHALL BE NON-METALLIC AND SHALL INCLUDE THE REDUCED LOOP TRAFFIC DETECTOR SERVICE CONNECTED FIBER OPTIC PULL BOXES SHALL BE 3' LONG BY 2 1/2' DEEP (INSIDE DIMENSIONS).

14. ALL FIELD WIRING SHALL BE NEATLY BUNDLED AND CLEARLY IDENTIFIED WITH PERMANENTLY LEGIBLE WEATHERPROOF TAGS THAT ARE SECURELY ATTACHED TO EACH CABLE. THE TAGGING SYSTEM PROPOSED SHALL BE SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL WITH THE NEAREST PROJECT SUBMITTALS REQUIRED FOR THIS PROJECT. THIS REQUIREMENT ALSO APPLIES TO THE MOST ARM TERMINAL COMPARTMENTS AND TO ALL PULL BOXES CONTAINING SPACED LOOP LEAD-INS.

15. EACH LOOP SHALL BE TREATED AS AN INDIVIDUAL LOOP WITH SEPARATE LEAD-INS FROM THE POINT TO CABINET TERMINAL. EXCEPT UPSTREAM ADVANCE DETECTION LOOPS WHICH SHALL BE PHASED TOGETHER ON A SINGLE LEAD-IN AT EACH ADVANCE LOOP STATION. WHENEVER MORE THAN TWO INDICANCE LOOPS ARE CONNECTED TO THE SAME DETECTOR, THEY SHALL BE WIRED IN SERIES/PARALLEL.

16. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE A TWO-WAY BUCKET TRUCK AND ASSIST THE PROJECT INSPECTOR IN PHYSICALLY EXAMINING EACH SIGNAL HEAD THE SAME DAY IT IS ERECTED. COST TO BE INCIDENTAL TO THE COST OF SIGNAL HEADS.

17. ONE WEEK PRIOR TO BEGINNING THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION PLEASE CONTACT MR. SCOTT (DISTRICT TRAFFIC OPERATIONS ENGINEER) DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AT (904) 208-5430 AND MR. RICHARD REED (TRAFFIC ENGINEER) AT (904) 208-0170.

18. TWO SIGNAL CABINET CONSULTS SHALL BE SUBMITTED AND CAPPED: ONE IN NEAREST SIGNAL CABLE PULL BOX AND ONE IN NEAREST LOOP PULL BOX.

19. PULL BOX AND CONDUIT RUN LOCATIONS SHOWN ARE APPROXIMATE AND ARE TO BE ADJUSTED AS NEEDED TO PROVIDE A SAFE INSTALLATION. ANY SIGNIFICANT ADJUSTMENT REQUIRED SHALL HAVE PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE ENGINEER.

20. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR HMO EXAMINATIONS (TO A DEPTH OF 5') OF EACH POLE LOCATION TO EXPOSE EXISTING UNDERGROUND UTILITIES AND FOR COORDINATING WITH ALL UTILITY COMPANIES AND INTERFERE UP TO THREE COORDINATIONS PER THE MOST ARMS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND EXPLAIN TO TOWNSMEN ANY LOCATION MAY BE REQUIRED. 26. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RETURN THE SITE SURROUNDING MOST ARMS TO ITS ORIGINAL CONDITION, AS ORDERED BY THE ENGINEER.

27. CABINET DOOR SHALL OPEN TO THE RIGHT OF WAY LINE AND AWAY FROM TRAFFIC.

28. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE BELOW TYPE 8438 ROADWAY LOOP WIRE OR EQUIVALENT TYPE WITH HIGH BEARLY CROSS-LINKED POLYETHYLENE INSULATED WIRE RATED 600 VOLTS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ENSURE THE LOOP LEAD-INS ARE GROUNDED IN THE CABINET.

30. A GREEN COLORED NO. 8 AWG INSULATED STANDEAD COPPER WIRE SHALL BE CONNECTED BETWEEN EACH OF THE INTERSECTION METAL MOST ARM AND PEDESTRIAN POLE GROUND ROD CONNECTION POINTS AND THEN TO THE CONTROLLER (GROUND BUS). THIS WIRE SHALL BE PULLED IN THE SAME CONDUIT AS THE SIGNAL CABLE.

33. AS DIRECTED BY THE PROJECT ENGINEER, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SAW-CUT AND TRENCH CONDUIT UNDER PAVEMENT IF JACKING CONDUIT OR CONDUIT BURNING SYSTEMS IS NOT FEASIBLE. SAW CUTTING AND TRENCHING SHALL BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO NEW ROADWAYS BASE COURSE.

34. WHEN MULTIPLE RUNS OF CONDUIT ARE PLACED UNDER PAVEMENT, ONLY ONE RUN SHALL BE PAID FOR AS UNDER PAVEMENT (OR UNDERGROUND - JACKED). ADDITIONAL RUNS WILL BE PAID FOR AS UNDERGROUND.

35. POLE CLOSURES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON WEEKENDS OR HOLIDAYS, NOR WILL THEY BE PERMITTED DURING THE HOURS OF 8:00 AM TO 8:00 PM AND 3:00 PM TO 7:00 PM. THE PROJECT ENGINEER MAY ADJUST THESE TIMES TO REFLECT ACTUAL FIELD CONDITIONS.

36. WHEN A CONTRACTOR IS WORKING ON SIGNAL WORK IN AN INTERSECTION (INSTALLING CONDUIT IN THE STREET, REMOVING EXISTING SIGNAL EQUIPMENT, INSTALLING SIGNAL EQUIPMENT, INSTALLING LOOPS AND RUNS, TURNING ON NEW SIGNALS), THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REQUIRE A LANE CLOSURE, AN OFF-DUTY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM THE OFFICE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY COMMUNICATIONS (804) 810-4971. THE COST ASSOCIATED WITH THE OFF-DUTY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER SHALL BE PAID FOR UNDER PAY ITEM 102-1-1.

37. TRAFFIC SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST EDITION OF THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (MUTCD) AND FOOT DESIGN STANDARDS REE-600 SERIES.

38. ALL UNDERGROUND CONDUIT CARRYING COMMUNICATIONS CABLE, INSTALLED BY OPEN TRENCHING METHODS, SHALL BE IDENTIFIED BY DETECTABLE CONDUIT IDENTIFICATION TAPE. IDENTIFICATION TAPE SHALL BE MINIMUM 8 INCHES WIDE AND BE OF A PLASTIC OR NON-DETERIORATING, NON-COLOR-FADING MATERIAL CAPABLE OF WITHSTANDING AT LEAST 600 PERCENT IN LENGTH BEFORE BREAKING. IDENTIFICATION TAPE SHALL BE COLORED ORANGE FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND SHALL BE CONTINUOUSLY APPLIED TO ALL CABLES WITH BLACK NON-FADING INK WITH THE MESSAGE "CAUTION TRAFFIC SIGNAL CABLE BURIED BELOW" IN MINIMUM 2 INCH HIGH BLOCK LETTERS. IDENTIFICATION TAPE SHALL BE INSTALLED FOR THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF TRENCH DIRECTED FOR ALL PARALLEL CONDUITS WITHIN 12 INCHES OF EACH OTHER. THE TAPE SHALL CONTAIN MORE THAN 12 INCHES APART SHALL HAVE TWO OR MORE IDENTIFICATION POINTS TO TERMINATION POINT AND SHALL ENTER PULL BOXES WITH THE CONDUIT. THE IDENTIFICATION TAPE SHALL BE AT A DEPTH OF 12 INCHES BELOW FINISHED GRADE. PROMOTION AND INSTALLATION OF THE IDENTIFICATION TAPE SHALL BE INCLUDED UNDER PAY ITEM 630-1-12, CONDUIT (UNDERGROUND) OR PAY ITEM 630-1-13 (UNDER PAVEMENT).




TYPICAL CABLE STRAIN RELIEF DETAIL






MAST ARM POLE DETAIL




**GATE VALVE AND BOX




