

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR RE-BID NO. 13-44R PURCHASE OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY FIRE RESCUE PHARMACEUTICAL SUPPLIES.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Kentron Health Care, Inc., Bound Tree Medical, LLC, Henry Schein Inc., QuadMed, Inc., and Midwest Medical Supply Co., LLC, to purchase Pharmaceutical Supplies for the SJC Fire Rescue Department; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the project shall consist of providing a variety of medications and medical supplies to St. Johns County Fire Rescue to use on an annual basis for emergency care, and

WHEREAS, through the County's formal bid process, Kentron Health Care, Inc., Bound Tree Medical, LLC, Henry Schein Inc., QuadMed, Inc., and Midwest Medical Supply Co., LLC, were determined to be a responsive, responsible bidders to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the contract is being funded by the Fire Rescue-Rescue Division and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the Contract (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that entering into the Contract serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award Re-Bid No. 13-44R to Kentron Health Care, Inc., Bound Tree Medical, LLC, Henry Schein Inc., QuadMed, Inc. and Midwest Medical Supply Co., LLC.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute a Contract with Kentron Health Care, Inc., Bound Tree Medical, LLC, Henry Schein Inc., QuadMed, Inc., and Midwest Medical Supply Co., LLC on behalf of the County for pharmaceutical supplies as specifically provided in the Bid Documents for Re-Bid No 13-44R.

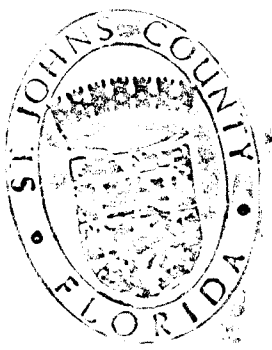
