

RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 148

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID NO. 13-57 AND TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2014 16,500 GVWR EXTENDED CAB TRUCKS 4X2 WITH SERVICE BODY AND 4,000 LB CRANE WITH 26,000 GCWR

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Rountree-Moore Ford to purchase Two (2) 2014 16,500 GVWR Extended Cab Trucks 4X2 with Service Body and 4,000 lb Crane with 26,000 GCWR; and; and

WHEREAS, through the County's formal bid process, Rountree-Moore Ford selected as the most qualified respondent to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the project is being funded by the Utility Department; and

WHEREAS, said purchase serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No. 13-57 to Rountree-Moore Ford ("Rountree-Moore"), and further authorized to execute a purchase order on behalf of the County for the purchase of Two (2) 2014 16,500 GVWR Extended Cab Trucks 4X2 with Service Body and 4,000 lb Crane with 26,000 GCWR as specifically provided in Bid No. 13-57.

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
