be and the same are hereby vacated, abandoned, discontinued and closed, and this Board hereby renounces and disclaims any right of the County and the Public in and to the above described right-of-way and any land in connection therewith, with the exception that the County retain a 15 foot easement across said lands for drainage lying 7.5 feet on either side of the centerline of said vacated right-of-way.

- 3. That the notice required by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes, of the adoption of this resolution is hereby authorized to be published.
- 4. That the applicant pays all recording costs.






