A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID NO. 14-48 AND TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR COUNTYWIDE ROADWAY STRIPING SERVICES (FY 14')

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with McShea Contracting, LLC.; Rose Services, Inc. & Southern States Pavement Markings, Inc. to provide services for Countywide Roadway Striping Services (FY 14'); and

WHEREAS, the scope of the project shall generally include furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and other items necessary for the providing striping services on an as-needed basis throughout St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, through the County's formal bid process, McShea Contracting, LLC.; Rose Services, Inc. & Southern States Pavement Markings, Inc. were selected as qualified respondents to enter into respective contracts with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the contracts attached hereto and finds that entering into the contracts serve a public purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No.14-48 Countywide Roadway Striping Services (FY 14') to McShea Contracting, LLC.; Rose Services, Inc. & Southern States Pavement Markings, Inc. as responsive, responsible bidders.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute contracts in substantially the same form and format as attached hereto with McShea Contracting, LLC.; Rose Services, Inc. & Southern States Pavement Markings, Inc. on behalf of the County for the Countywide Roadway Striping Services (FY 14') as specifically provided in

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
