A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 GENERAL FUND/ANIMAL CONTROL DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED DONATIONS AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE TO ENHANCE THE ANIMAL CONTROL OPERATIONS IN FY 2014.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing the budget for Fiscal Year 2013 did not appropriate donations made for use by the St. Johns County Animal Control Department; and

WHEREAS, as of June 3, 2014, an additional \$9,528.61 in unrestricted donations made to the St. Johns County Animal Control Department have been received; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County Animal Control needs to recognize the donations in order to authorize its expenditure for St. Johns County Animal Control Department operational enhancements within FY 2014;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact.
- 2. The General Fund and Animal Control Department expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated funds in the amount of \$9,528.61.
- 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
