## RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR, OR DESIGNEE, TO DIRECT STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE ST. JOHNS RIVER WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT (SJRWMD) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 COOPERATIVE FUNDING GRANT.

## **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, By participating in the St. Johns River Water Management District's Algal Initiative, the County is required to identify and implement projects that will reduce nutrients discharged to the Lower St. Johns River (LSJR) in accordance with the DEP adopted LSJR Basin Management Action Plan (BMAP). Staff will identify cost effective projects to reduce nutrients discharged to the LSJR that meet the requirements of this cooperative funding opportunity; and

WHEREAS, Staff will identify cost effective projects to reduce nutrients discharged to the LSJR that meet the requirements of this cooperative funding opportunity; and

WHEREAS, The St. Johns River Water Management District will begin accepting applications on February 3, 2014 for cost share funding for water conservation, and construction projects that will contribute to any of the following type of projects, and that will reduce nutrient loading in springsheds, and other water bodies with established nutrient total maximum daily loads (TMDLs), water resource development, and alternative water supply development.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- **Section 2.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator, or his designee, to direct staff to submit a 2014-2015 cooperative funding grant application on behalf of the County and execute all required documents to the St. Johns River Water Management District.
- **Section 3.** To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
