## RESOLUTION 2014 - 214

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 COUNTY STATE HOUSING INITIATIVE FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY SHIP DIVISION.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has a SHIP Division which operates through a Special Revenue Fund budget funded primarily by the State of Florida and administered by the Florida Housing Finance Corporation; and

WHEREAS, it is known that the County will receive revenues that was not anticipated for Fiscal Year 2014; and

WHEREAS, the unanticipated revenue amount is \$947,719; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing its budget for Fiscal Year 2014, did not anticipate these revenues; and

WHEREAS, recognizing \$947,719 to increase to the State Housing Initiative Fund budget will allow for appropriation of the funds to the SHIP Department for payment of expenses associated with Fiscal Year 2014 events.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
- 2. The State Housing Initiative Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$947,719 for Fiscal Year 2014.
- 3. Such funds shall be appropriated to the SHIP Department for payment of expenses associated with Fiscal Year 2014 events.
- 4. To the extent that there are scriveners, typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
