

RESOLUTION 2014 - 216

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 COUNTY PIER FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY PIER DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, St. Johns County has a County Pier Department which operates through a Special Revenue Fund budget funded primarily by the collection of fees; and

WHEREAS, it is projected that the County will receive unanticipated revenues in the amount of \$15,000 from the diversification of merchandise sold and the rental of beach supplies; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing its budget for Fiscal Year 2014, did not anticipate the diversification of merchandise sold and the rental of beach supplies; and

WHEREAS, recognizing and appropriating the \$15,000 to the Pier Fund will allow for payment of expenses associated with the purchase of merchandise for resale and supplies for rent.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
2. The Pier Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be increased to reflect the unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$15,000 for Fiscal Year 2014.
3. Such funds shall be appropriated to the County Pier Department for payment of expenses associated with the purchase of merchandise for resale and supplies for rent.
4. To the extent that there are scrivener, typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
