RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners annual budget is annually prepared to capture all expenditures including grant funds which may be received by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Health Bureau of Emergency Medical Services has made available grant dollars for the purpose of improving and expanding pre-hospital EMS; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Health Bureau of Emergency Medical Services has awarded an EMS County grant to St. Johns County for Fiscal Year 2014 in the amount of \$15,952; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, when preparing its budget for Fiscal Year 2014, did not anticipate receiving additional grant funds from the Florida Department of Health Bureau of Emergency Medical Services for the purpose of improving and expanding pre-hospital EMS.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
- 2. The FY 2014 General Fund's revenue budget and EMS Department's expenditure budget shall reflect appropriations related to this grant from the Florida Department of Health Bureau of Emergency Medical Services in the amount of \$15,952.
- 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, and/or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
