

RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 185

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID NO. 15-55 AND TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR ANASTASIA ISLAND WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY RESIDENTIAL REUSE SYSTEM**

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to enter into a contract with WPC Industrial Contractors, Inc. to provide services for construction of Anastasia Island Wastewater Treatment Facility Residential Reuse System; and

**WHEREAS**, the scope of the project shall generally include furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and other items necessary for the construction of a residential reuse system; and

**WHEREAS**, through the County's formal bid process, WPC Industrial Contractors, LLC was selected as the most qualified respondent to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the proposed contract (attached hereto and incorporated herein), and finds that entering into the contract serves a public purpose.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.


Section 2. The County Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No. 15-55 Anastasia Island Wastewater Treatment Facility Residential Reuse System to WPC Industrial Contractors, LLC as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or his designee, is further authorized to execute a contract in substantially the same form and format as attached with WPC Industrial Contractors, LLC on behalf of the County for the completion of the Anastasia Island Wastewater Treatment Facility Residential Reuse System as specifically provided in Bid No 15-55.


