A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID NO. 15-12 AND TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL GOLF PARKWAY (IGP) RECLAIMED WATER AND FORCE MAIN

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with TB Landmark Construction, Inc. to provide services for construction of International Golf Parkway (IGP) Reclaimed Water and Force Main; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the project shall generally include furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and other items necessary for specified construction of a reclaimed water and force main along International Golf Parkway (IGP); and

WHEREAS, through the County's formal bid process, T B Landmark Construction, Inc. was selected as the most qualified respondent to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the proposed contract (attached hereto and incorporated herein), and finds that entering into the contract serves a public purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No. 15-12 International Golf Parkway (IGP) Reclaimed Water and Force Main to T B Landmark Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or his designee, is further authorized to execute a contract in substantially the same form and format as attached with TB Landmark Construction, Inc. on behalf of the County for the completion of International Golf Parkway (IGP) Reclaimed Water and Force Main as specifically provided in Bid No 15-12.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
