

RESOLUTION NO. 2015 - 231

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID 15-54 AND TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMPLEX REPIPING SERVICES.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with W. W. Gay Mechanical Contractor, Inc. to perform Mechanical Construction services for St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the services shall include replacement of the existing in-ground copper domestic water supply lines to the 4-story housing building for the Criminal Justice Complex; and

WHEREAS, through the County's formal Bid process, W. W. Gay Mechanical Contractor, Inc. was selected as a qualified respondent to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the material terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the proposed contract (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that entering into such a contract serves a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the proposed contract will be finalized with W.W. Gay Mechanical Contractor, Inc.; and will be in substantially the same form and format as the attached draft.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.


Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award BID 15-54 to W. W. Gay Mechanical Contractor, Inc., and to provide the services set forth therein.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute an agreement in substantially the same form and format as the attached draft with W. W. Gay Mechanical Contractor, Inc. on behalf of the County to provide the scope of services as specifically provided in BID 15-54.



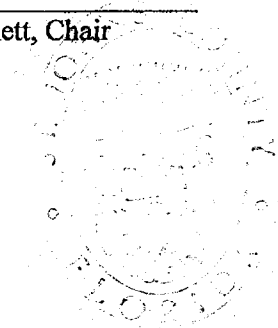
