A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF, OR DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION SEEKING FUNDING ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2015 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG), STATE SOLICITATION.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement anticipates an award from the United States Department of Justice through the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula Program: State Solicitation, in the amount of \$53,752 for St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, JAG funded projects may be used by St. Johns County local units of government to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system.; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office, together with the City of St. Augustine, and City of St. Augustine Beach, are requesting to use the grant funding for equipment totaling \$53,752; and

WHEREAS, the FDLE requires the Board of County Commissioners to authorize their acceptance through a Certificate of Participation; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the Grant announcement materials, the County has determined that nothing contained in the Grant application negatively impacts the interests of the County; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida that:

- Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.
- **Section 2.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves and authorizes the Sheriff of St. Johns County, Florida, or his designee, to submit an application seeking funding assistance through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).
- Section 3. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the Sheriff of St. Johns County, Florida, or his designee, to execute any other paperwork necessary to, or associated with, the application for the Department of the Justice Grant.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
