RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE GRANT CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA AND TO RECOGNIZE AND APPROPRIATE WITH THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has announced that St. Johns County, Florida is eligible to receive a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant with a Federal contribution up to \$2,289,906; and

WHEREAS, when preparing the Fiscal Year 2016 St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners Recommended Budget, did not anticipate receiving a SAFER grant; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that accepting the terms of and entering into the grant agreement will serve the interests of the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners approves the terms, conditions, and requirements of the grant award and authorizes the County Administrator or his designee to accept the award on behalf of the County, and recognizes and appropriates the grant within the FY 2016 Budget.
- 3. To the extent there are typographical errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
