

RESOLUTION 2017 - 116

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO SIGN AN AMENDMENT TO THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN HOME AGAIN ST. JOHNS, INC. AND THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, Home Again St. Johns, Inc. and the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners entered into an agreement for the implementation of the TANF Grant on March 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, both said parties wish to amend the agreement to clarify that the Responsibility for Grant Administration, and Time and Performance of the agreement shall take effect as of December 16, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the agreement has been amended as noted above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above Recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution, and are adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the terms, conditions, and provisions of the amendment of the agreement between Home Again St. Johns, Inc. and the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners, and authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to execute the attached amendment.

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical, administrative or scrivener's errors that do not change the tone, tenor or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without further action by the Board of County Commissioners.


Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT

This Contract Amendment (Amendment) is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2017 between St. Johns County ("the County" or "Subrecipient"), a political subdivision of the state of Florida, and Home Again St. Johns, Inc. ("Home Again" or "SJC COC Lead Agency"), a Florida not-for-profit corporation.

WHEREAS, Home Again is a recipient of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) grant funds from the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF); and

WHEREAS, the County and Home Again entered into a subrecipient agreement for the implementation of the TANF grant on March 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the subrecipient agreement to clarify provisions related to responsibility for grant administration and time of performance.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 1 of the subrecipient agreement is amended as follows:

Responsibility for Grant Administration: The SJC COC LEAD AGENCY is responsible for ensuring the administration of TANF GRANT funds in accordance with all requirements set forth in its contract with DCF dated December 16, 2016 and attached hereto as Attachment A. SUBRECIPIENT agrees to comply with all terms and conditions for the TANF GRANT set forth by DCF in its contract with the SJC COC LEAD AGENCY. SUBRECIPIENT agrees to perform all services and activities funded under the TANF GRANT in compliance with all applicable regulations, laws, and other requirements set forth by DCF and in this AGREEMENT, or amendments thereto, and in Florida Statutes.

2. Section 5 of the subrecipient agreement is amended as follows:

Time of Performance: This AGREEMENT shall take effect as of December 16, 2016, through and including June 30, 2019.

3. Except as expressly modified by this Amendment, the subrecipient agreement remains unchanged.
