RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING AND APPROPRIATING A US DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FEMA GRANT AND A STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 GENERAL FUND HURRICANE MATTHEW DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Hurricane Matthew inflicted severe impacts to Florida, Georgia, South Carolina and North Carolina resulting in a presidential declaration for federal assistance in St. Johns County as the County experienced damage and inundation of sand to many of its public beach parks and access points as a result of Hurricane Matthew; and

WHEREAS, the County took the necessary actions before, during, and after the disaster to save lives, protect public health and safety, and prevent damage to improved public health and safety, and prevent damage to improved public property; and

WHEREAS, the County estimates the eligible costs for emergency protective measures to be \$1,881,163.20 related to Hurricane Matthew; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$1,410,873 from a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant related to Hurricane Matthew which necessitates a County match; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$235,145 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant; and

WHEREAS, the County did not anticipate either an award of a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant or a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant related to Hurricane Matthew during the Fiscal Year 2017 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the County must recognize and appropriate \$1,410,873 from a Department of Homeland Security FEMA and \$235,145 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant within the Fiscal Year 2017 General Fund; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.

- 2. The Board of County Commissioners recognizes and appropriates a tentative Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant for up to \$1,410,873 and a tentative State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant for up to \$235,145 related to Hurricane Matthew within the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget.
- 3. To the extent there are typographical errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
