RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING AND APPROPRIATING A US DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FEMA GRANT AND A STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 GENERAL FUND HURRICANE MATTHEW DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Hurricane Matthew inflicted severe impacts to Florida, Georgia, South Carolina and North Carolina to which St. Johns County procured and contracted with the Ardurra Group related to disaster recovery management; and

WHEREAS, the estimate for task order 4 related to disaster recovery management is \$2,976,714 to provide expertise in identifying potential reimbursable projects through FEMA's Public Assistance Program, of which, it is estimated, that 100% of Ardurra's cost on this initial task, may be eligible for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$2,232,536 from a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant related to Hurricane Matthew which necessitates a County match; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$372,089 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant; and

WHEREAS, the County did not anticipate either an award of a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant or a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant related to Hurricane Matthew during the Fiscal Year 2017 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the County must recognize and appropriate \$2,232,536 from a Department of Homeland Security FEMA and \$372,089 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant within the Fiscal Year 2017 General Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners recognizes and appropriates a tentative Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant for up to \$2,232,536 and a tentative State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant for up to \$372,089 related to Hurricane Matthew within the Fiscal Year 2017 General Fund Hurricane Matthew Department.

- 3. The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Administrator, or his designee, to execute task order 4 substantially in the same form as attached.
- 4. To the extent there are typographical errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

TASK ORDER 4 SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Ardurra Group and Constantine Engineering are pleased to present to St. Johns County Task Order # 4 as part of the continuing partnership in the Hurricane Matthew recovery initiatives and programmatic implementation.

Continuation of Services

Several specific task assignments identified in the previous Task Order 1 scope language are inherently part of the ongoing level of activity associated with the St. Johns County recovery plan. These items include The Ardurra Group and Constantine Engineering continuing to:

- **A.** Provide expertise in identifying potential reimbursable projects through FEMA's Public Assistance Program.
- **B.** Develop a process/system for St. Johns County, from inception through the project closeout, to prepare and submit its Public Assistance program including documentation, procurement and contract data, payroll records, grant submission support, and direct administrative functions per FEMA's Public Assistance Program requirements.
- C. Develop processes for obtaining, gathering analyzing and field documentation including, but not limited to, records related to procured goods and services, timekeeping, and force account labor and equipment. Integrate data into the Syncplicity data management system.
- **D.** Attend all meetings with FEMA, State, insurance representatives and Public Meetings as well as regular participation with the County's designated FEMA workgroup.
- **E.** Identify and communicate risks that could preclude our ability to optimize reimbursement.
- **F.** Assist in the preparation of accurate Public Assistance emergency and permanent work project estimates including, but not limited to, recognized cost estimating, developing detailed damage descriptions and dimensions, scope of work, and proper identification of force account labor and equipment.
- **G.** Assist the County in identifying and leveraging other sources of financial aid including, but not limited to, Federal, State, Local and private entities.
- **H.** Status Reporting. Develop and provide weekly status updating to include a Plan of Action and Milestones (POA&M) for each area:
 - Status of each project worksheet (examples time, money, cost and completion). Each project worksheet would be ranked in order by priority.
 - Status of each task order
 - Funding source status
 - FEMA public assistance
 - US Army Corps of Engineers

- State of Florida
- Community Development Block Grant
- Hazard Mitigation Grant Program
- Community Disaster Loans

The Ardurra – Constantine leadership recognizes the value of the County's time and anticipates attending an executive level meeting once a month to maintain executive level engagement and support of the program (status report) and will be more than happy to attend additional executive level conferences as requested by the county.

I. Contracts Compliance, Assistance with Solicitations: At the County's request review, selected "Disaster Recovery Contracts" and associated contractors invoices per contract and RFP compliance; including scope, rate, deliverables, and minority participation per submitted proposals and SJC contracts; include minority subcontracting plans review, minority subcontracts/services per contract, and adherence to minority participation. Make recommendations for corrections and maintaining.

Disaster Solicitations – assist in preparation of and/or review of disaster recovery solicitations and Purchase Orders, Task Order for federal, state, compliance for disaster reimbursement and or future grants funding.

- J. Recovery Costs Reconciliations & Pre Audits: Assist County in researching, collecting and formulating responses to all request for information to the County. (i.e. OIG, state and local audit request)
- K. Procurement & Contract Management/Monitoring Support: Ensure that procurement procedures and contracts with suppliers, professional service providers and general contractors are in compliance with Federal contract requirements and per funding mechanisms.

Provide process of contract monitoring, and ensure recovery contractors adhere to deliverables, schedules, and rates.

Change in scope or additional work are—documented per federal compliance for disaster reimbursement.

L. More apt to Task Order 4 is the specialized assistance to be provided to St. Johns
County over the next 12 months as follows. It should be noted that the following
identified assistance represents a current perspective of project development and with it

incurs a fairly high likelihood to be modified by the engagement and work with FEMA, which is projected to continue well beyond the next year. Subsequent reviews and Task Orders will be necessary to effectively complete the recovery program for St. Johns County. The following tasks also DO NOT include specific work relative to the concurrent Task Order 3 with respect to CDBG-DR assistance and project development. It is anticipated that while the two Task Orders will eventually be incorporated into one, the current proposed Task Order 4 remains independent in scope and funding from Task Order 3.
