

RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 183

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD BID NO. 17-30 AND TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR CR 210 AT CR 2209 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into contract with Florida Safety Contractors, Inc. to provide services for the CR 210 at CR 2209 Intersection Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the Project consists of the removal of existing pavement, existing curb & gutter, existing concrete traffic separator, existing signage, and existing signal heads, and construction of pavement widening, pavement milling and resurfacing, curb & gutter, concrete traffic separator, signs, pavement striping, signal heads, and traffic loops for CR 210 and CR 2209 in St. Johns County, Florida; and;

WHEREAS, through the County's formal Bid process, Florida Safety Contractors, Inc. was selected as the most qualified respondent to enter into a contract with the County to perform the work referenced above; and;

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the proposed contract (attached hereto, an incorporated herein) and finds that entering into contracts to complete the work services serves a public purpose; and;

WHEREAS, the contract will be finalized after negotiations but will be in substantial conformance with the attached draft contract.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to award Bid No. 17-30 to Florida Safety Contractors, Inc. in the amount of four hundred twenty-six thousand, seven hundred fifty dollars and zero cents (\$426,750.00) and to conduct negotiations to provide the services set forth therein.

Section 3. Upon successful negotiations, the County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute agreements in substantially the same form and format as the attached draft on behalf of the County to provide the scope of services as specifically provided in Bid No. 17-30.

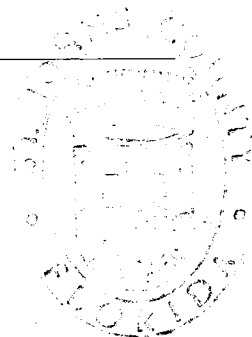

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received **until 2:00 P.M.** on **May 3, 2017**, by David Klages, Contract Coordinator, St. Johns County Purchasing Department located at **500 San Sebastian View, St. Augustine, Florida 32084** (904) 209-0150 for **Bid No. 17-30; CR 210 at CR 2209 Intersection Improvements**. Bids will be opened promptly after the 2:00 P.M. deadline. **Note:** Bids delivered or received in the Purchasing Department after the 2:00 P.M. deadline shall not be given consideration and shall be returned to sender unopened.

Scope of Work:

This project consists of removal of existing pavement, existing curb & gutter, existing concrete traffic separator, existing signage, and existing signal heads, and construction of pavement widening, pavement milling and resurfacing, curb & gutter, concrete traffic separator, signs, pavement striping, signal heads, and traffic loops for CR 210 and CR 2209 in St. Johns County, Florida.

There will be a **Mandatory** Pre-Bid Conference on **Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at 2:00 P.M.** at the St. Johns County Administration Building, 500 San Sebastian View, St. Augustine, FL 32084 in the Aviles Conference Room. **“Anyone arriving after the scheduled time will not be granted admittance. Any company not in attendance and signed in at this meeting will not be permitted to submit a bid.”**

The deadline for questions for this bid shall be **Wednesday, April 19, 2017 at 4:00 P.M.**

Minimum Qualifications:

Minimum Qualifications: Bidders must be fully licensed to do business in the State of Florida and must have successfully constructed, as a prime contractor or subcontractor, at least three (3) projects of the type, size, and dollar value of the construction proposed for this project, and must have been in business as a contractor for at least five (5) years.

Additionally, the prime or sub-contractor performing the work in the following work classes shall be currently FDOT pre-qualified: 1) Flexible Paving and 2) Signalization.

Any bidder, proposer or person substantially and adversely affected by an intended decision or by any term, condition, procedure or specification with respect to any bid, invitation, solicitation of proposals or requests for qualifications, shall file with the Purchasing Department for St. Johns County, a written notice of intent to protest no later than 72 hours (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays for employees of St. Johns County) after the posting either electronically or by other means of the notice of intended action, not of intended award, bid tabulation, publication by posting electronically or by other means of a procedure, specification, term or condition which the person intends to protest, or the right to protest such matter shall be waived. The protest procedures may be obtained from the Purchasing Department and are included in the County’s Purchasing Manual. All of the terms and conditions of the County Purchasing Manual are incorporated by reference and are fully binding.

Vendors shall not contact, lobby, or otherwise communicate with any SJC employee, including any member of the Board of County Commissioners, other than the above referenced individual from the point of advertisement of the Bid until contract(s) are executed by all parties, per SJC Purchasing Code 304.6.5 “Procedures Concerning Lobbying”. According

to SJC policy, any such communication shall disqualify the vendor, contractor, or consultant from responding to the subject invitation to bid, request for quote, request for proposal, invitation to negotiate, or request for qualifications.

St. Johns County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids/proposals, waive minor formalities, and to award the bid/proposal that best serves the interests of St. Johns County. St. Johns County also reserves the right to award the base bid and any alternate bids in any combination that best suits the needs of the County.

Regarding Plan sheet 17 – note 4, the P.M. lane closure restrictions are listed as 3:30 P.M. to 6:30 P.M. This has been revised to 3:30 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. Night work is optional with prior County approval.


3. Are there noise restrictions? If so, what are they?



The Undersigned agrees, if awarded the Contract, to Substantially Complete all work within **ninety (90)** consecutive calendar days of the Notice to Proceed. Undersigned further agrees that from the compensation otherwise to be paid, the Owner may retain the liquidated damages as provided in the Contract, which sum is agreed upon as the proper measure of liquidated damages which the Owner will sustain each day by the failure of the Undersigned to complete the work in the time stipulated, and this sum is not to be construed as penalty.
