

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-270

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN TIPPING FEES AND OTHER CHARGES PERTAINING TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL PURSUANT TO THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY SOLID WASTE ORDINANCE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Section 403.706(1), Florida Statutes, authorizes counties to charge reasonable fees for the handling and disposal of Solid Waste at their facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 18.H of the Solid Waste Ordinance provides that the fees and service charges that are paid to the County for receiving and disposing of Solid Waste at a County Landfill shall be established by resolution of the Board; and

WHEREAS, by passage of this resolution, the Board intends to establish such fees and charges; and

WHEREAS, the fees and charges established in this resolution are reasonable, based on a number of factors, including, but not limited to, the amount, characteristics, and form of the Solid Waste brought to the County's facilities for disposal and the costs incurred by the County in handling and disposing of Solid Waste in its Solid Waste disposal system; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously adopted Resolution Nos. 1990-165, 1991-135, 1992-150, 1994-118a, 1998-155, 2000-148, 2005-216, 2006-287, 2006-289, and 2008-242, which established fees and service charges for receiving and disposing of Solid Waste at a County Landfill; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Nos. 1990-165, 1991-135, 1992-150, 1994-118a, 1998-155, 2000-148, 2005-216, 2006-287, 2006-289, and 2008-242 were adopted pursuant to ordinances that have since been repealed, replaced, and superseded by the Solid Waste Ordinance and are therefore due to be rescinded; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds and determines that adoption of this resolution is in the public interest of the citizens of St. Johns County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this resolution, and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. Resolution Nos. 1990-165, 1991-135, 1992-150, 1994-118a, 1998-155, 2000-148, 2005-216, 2006-287, 2006-289, and 2008-242 are rescinded. Such rescission shall not reinstate or preserve any St. Johns County resolutions, as amended, previously rescinded by the Board of County Commissioners, including but not limited to any resolutions rescinded by Resolution Nos. 1990-165, 1991-135, 1992-150, 1994-118a, 1998-155, 2000-148, 2005-216, 2006-287, 2006-289, and 2008-242.

Section 3. "Solid Waste Ordinance," when used in this resolution, shall mean St. Johns County Ordinance No. 2017-39.

Section 4. The definitions set forth in Section 2 of the Solid Waste Ordinance are adopted and incorporated in this resolution.

Section 5. Pursuant to Section 18 of the Solid Waste Ordinance, the following fees and charges for the disposal of Solid Waste in a County Landfill shall be charged and collected:

- A. Across weigh scales (per ton) for packer trucks, roll-off containers, front-end loaders, and other vehicles and trailers (Commercial Waste and Industrial Waste): **\$57.00 per ton**
- B. "Per ton" fee, pursuant to Section 18.B of the Solid Waste Ordinance (to be calculated and charged in the event the County's weighing scales are out of service and the average weight of the vehicles, as previously determined with the County's scales, are not available): **\$6.50 per cubic yard**
- C. Pressure treated lumber: **\$57.00 per ton**
- D. Waste Tires (if 10 or fewer delivered at the same time): **\$2.25 each**
- E. Waste Tires (if more than 10 delivered at the same time): **\$120.00 per ton**
- F. Fluorescent light bulbs (2-4 feet in length): **\$0.50 each**
- G. Fluorescent light bulbs (6-8 feet in length): **\$1.00 each**
- H. Containers containing latex paint: **\$2.00 per gallon**
- I. Containers containing oil-based paint: **\$3.00 per gallon**

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect on upon adoption.

Section 7. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners
