

RESOLUTION NO: 2017 - 38

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AUTHORIZE AN ADDITIONAL, FIVE (5) YEAR RENEWAL FOR THE CONTRACT WITH PIERCE MANUFACTURING, INC UNDER RFP #07-53.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, in 2007, the County advertised a solicitation for the purchase of fire apparatus and special application vehicles, under RFP No: 07-53; and

WHEREAS, a contract was awarded to Pierce Manufacturing, Inc for an initial term of five (5) years, with one five (5) year renewal available for exercise by the County, which was exercised by the County on December 5, 2011, and became effective as of March 1, 2012, and remains in effect through February 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, associated with the contract between the County and Pierce Manufacturing, there is an access fee that is assessed to other agencies and organizations who piggyback the agreement to make purchases, which is provided to the County as a credit against purchases made; and

WHEREAS, since the beginning of the contract, the County has received \$224,998.57 from access fees; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns Fire Rescue has requested to authorize a second, five (5) year renewal period be added to the agreement with Pierce Manufacturing, which would become effective on March 1, 2017, and will remain in effect through and until February 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, through negotiations, Pierce Manufacturing has offered to increase the access fee for the County to .75%, over the current .5%; has offered to provide two (2) scholarships to training for SJC designated attendees at any Pierce-related training event, which would cover the cost of the training and any course-related materials.
; and

WHEREAS, the project is being funded by Fire Rescue Administration; and

WHEREAS, said purchase serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA:

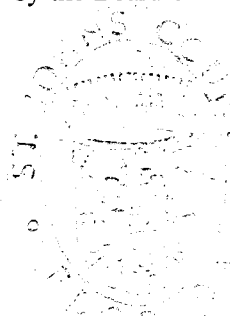
Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.

Section 2. The County Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award an additional five (5) year renewal to the Contract with Pierce Manufacturing, under RFP No: 07-53 and further authorized to execute an amendment on behalf of the County for the renewal.

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

It was a pleasure meeting with you last week to discuss modification of the contract to allow for an additional renewal period of five years. We sincerely appreciate the business relationship that we have enjoyed with St. Johns County and look forward to the possibility of continuing this great contract.


For your records, we are enclosing a current spreadsheet, which shows all customers who have accessed the contract and also expenditures made by St. Johns County Fire Rescue utilizing contract access funds. This Contract Amendment ("Amendment") is made by and between St. Johns County, FL, ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Florida, with principal offices located at 500 San Sebastian View, St. Augustine, FL 32084, and **Pierce Manufacturing, Inc**, ("Contractor"), authorized to do business in the State of Florida, with mailing address: 2600 American Drive, P.O. Box 2017, Appleton, WI, 54912-2017; Phone: (920) 832-3000; Fax: (920) 832-3208; and Email: frfbogus@yahoo.com.

WHEREAS, in 2007, the County advertised a solicitation for the purchase of fire apparatus and special application vehicles, under RFP No: 07-53; and

WHEREAS, a contract was awarded to Pierce Manufacturing, Inc for an initial term of five (5) years, with one five (5) year renewal available for exercise by the County, which was exercised by the County on December 5, 2011, and became effective as of March 1, 2012, and remains in effect through February 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, associated with the contract between the County and Pierce Manufacturing, there is an access fee that is assessed to other agencies and organizations who piggyback the agreement to make purchases, which is provided to the County as a credit against purchases made; and

WHEREAS, since the beginning of the contract, the County has received \$224,998.57 from access fees; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns Fire Rescue has requested to authorize a second, five (5) year renewal period be added to the agreement with Pierce Manufacturing, which would become effective on March 1, 2017, and will remain in effect through and until February 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, through negotiations, Pierce Manufacturing has offered to increase the access fee for the County to .75%, over the current .5%; has offered to provide two (2) scholarships to training for SJC designated attendees at any Pierce-related training event, which would cover the cost of the training and any course-related materials.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the compensation and covenants hereinafter mentioned:

1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Amendment, and such recitals shall constitute findings of fact.
2. Article 2 shall be amended to add one (1) five (5) year renewal period, which shall become effective on March 1, 2017, and shall remain in effect through and until February 28, 2022.
3. Article 2 shall be amended to increase the access fee to .75% or $\frac{3}{4}\%$ of the sale price of each unit purchased off the contract by an outside agency, which will be credited back to the County to be applied to future purchases.
4. The Contractor shall provide two (2) scholarships for County designated attendees for any Pierce-related training, which shall cover costs of training and course-related materials.
5. With the exception of the changes, amendments, modifications and revisions noted in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions contained in the Contract as previously amended shall remain in full force and effect. The County and the Contractor acknowledge that any further changes, amendments, modification or revisions to the Contract shall be in writing and executed by duly authorized representatives of each party.

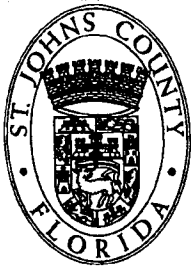

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 1st day of March 2007 by and between **ST. JOHNS COUNTY**, hereinafter called "OWNER", and **Pierce Manufacturing Inc., P. O. Box 2017, Appleton, WI 54912, (920) 832-4273** hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR".

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payment and agreements hereinafter mentioned;

1. The CONTRACTOR will supply fire apparatus and special application vehicles to St. Johns County Fire Rescue listed on General Services Administration, GSA Federal Supply Schedule 23, Contract # GS-30F-1045D in accordance with RFP No. 07-53.

2. The CONTRACTOR agrees to provide the item(s) as described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS for a five-year term beginning March 1, 2007 and ending February 28, 2012 unless extended.
