RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING AND APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDING PROVIDED BY NORTHEAST FLORIDA HEALTHCARE COALITION FOR THE PURCHASE OF PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF MASS CASUALTY INCIDENT (MCI) BAGS.

WHEREAS, the County has been awarded grant funding from the Northeast Florida Healthcare Coalition in the amount of \$9,680; and

WHEREAS, the County did not anticipate receiving funding through this grant program during the Fiscal Year 2019 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the County must recognize and appropriate \$9,680 from the Northeast Florida Healthcare Coalition within the Fiscal Year 2019 budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
2. The Board of County Commissioners recognizes and appropriates a contribution of \$9,680 from Northeast Florida Healthcare Coalition related to the Fiscal Year 2019 Budget.
3. To the extent there are typographical errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

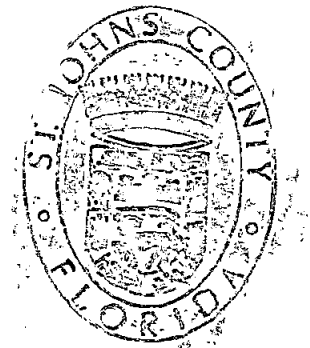
