## RESOLUTION NO: 2019 - 385

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE STANDARDIZATION OF ZOLL MANUFACTURING CARDIAC CARE EQUIPMENT FOR ST. JOHNS COUNTY FIRE RESCUE.

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County seeks to standardize the use of Zoll Manufacturing cardiac care equipment throughout St. Johns County Fire Rescue in order to provide continuity in patient care; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the St. Johns County Purchasing Manual, the County may standardize equipment for compatibility with existing equipment, ease of maintenance and cost of additional training if different equipment is purchased; and

WHEREAS, SJCFR has purchased a large inventory of Zoll Manufacturing cardiac care equipment, with cardiac monitors, external defibrillators, and ResQCPR devices; and

WHEREAS, all purchases of Zoll Manufacturing equipment will be funded by SJC Fire Rescue, unless alternative funding sources are identified for a specific purchase;

WHEREAS, the County finds that standardizing this equipment serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.
- Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to purchase Zoll Manufacturing cardiac care equipment as the standard for the County for cardiac care equipment.
- Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute and issue purchase orders for the purchased equipment without further BOCC approvals.
- Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
