A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO PIGGYBACK THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION CONTRACT NO: FSA19-VEH17.0 AND TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) 6" TRAILER MOUNTED SOLIDS HANDLING SOUND ATTENUATED VACUUM-ASSISTED PUMPS FROM THOMPSON PUMP FOR THE SJC UTILITY DEPARTMENT.

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County seeks to purchase three (3) 6" Trailer Mounted Solids Handling Sound Attenuated Vacuum-Assisted Pumps for the SJC Utility Department; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 302.6.5.4 of the St. Johns County Purchasing Manual, entitled "Piggyback or Cooperative Purchasing", the County is authorized make said purchase subject to the terms and conditions of Florida Sheriff's Association Contract #FSA19-VEH17.0 ("Contract"); and

WHEREAS, purchase of the equipment will be funded by the SJC Utility Department; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the terms, provisions, conditions and requirements of the Contract and finds that entering into the Contract for purchase of the loader serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as finds of fact.
- Section 2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to piggyback the Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No: FSA19-VEH17.0 for the purchase of three (3) 6" Trailer Mountèd Solids Handling Sound Attenuated Vacuum-Assisted Pumps.
- Section 3. In accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract, the County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to execute and issue a purchase order in the amount of \$154,766.00 to Thompson Pump for the specified equipment.
- Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
