

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 416

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, NAMING A COUNTY FACILITY IN HONOR OF JESSIE MELCOLM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jesse Melcolm was a lifelong resident of St. Johns County, and a local athlete who tragically died of meningitis at the age of 19 in November 2018; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution 99-152, the Jade Brown and the Creeks Baseball Club (a division of the Creekside Athletic Association) requests that a ballfield at the Rivertown Baseball Complex (Ball Field No. 1) be named in honor of Jessie Melcolm; and

WHEREAS, the request was initially considered by the Recreation Advisory Board, which voted to forward the request to the Board of County Commissioners with a recommendation for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. In accordance with the policy for naming public facilities provided in Resolution No. 99-152, the Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the request to name Ball Field No. 1 at the Rivertown Baseball Complex "Jessie Melcolm Field."

Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective upon execution by the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners.
