## **RESOLUTION 2019 - 440**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET TO RECEIVE UNANTICIPATED REVENUE; AND AUTHORIZING ITS APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE BY THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department has established a process by which athletic organizations or individuals may propose modifications or improvements to County-owned recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the process involves submitting a Facility Modification form that includes a detailed description of the project, quotes for completion of the work and a donation of funding to complete the work; and

WHEREAS, the Ponte Vedra Athletic Association (PVAA) submitted a request to modify Baseball Field No. 6 at Davis Park to accommodate the growing number of younger players (Project); and

WHEREAS, PVAA has donated \$4,660 to the County for completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the County, when preparing its budget for Fiscal Year 2020, did not anticipate the \$4,550 donation; and

WHEREAS, amending the Fiscal Year 2020 budget to recognize the donated funds and to appropriate such funds for completion of the Project serves a public purpose.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- 2. The Board hereby recognizes the \$4,660 donation by PVAA for modifications to Baseball Field No. 6 at Davis Park as unanticipated revenue, and authorizes appropriation of the funding in the Fiscal Year 2020 budget for use as described herein.
- 3. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board.
