RESOLUTION THE **BOARD COUNTY** COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE SIXTEENTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NJ206 BETWEEN ST. JOHNS COUNTY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACT NJ206 BETWEEN ST. JOHNS COUNTY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES FOR THE ADDITIONAL SOLE PURPOSE OF ALLOCATION OF UNDER THE CONTRACT. **SUBJECT FUNDING** SUBSEQUENT RATIFICATION AND BUDGETING APPROPRIATION OF SUCH FUNDS BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Children and Families (the Department) wishes to amend contract number NJ206, entered into between said parties on May 27, 2014, and last amended on June 22, 2018, for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this amendment is to insert the Schedule of Funds, Attachment II-E, for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 with version 11/30/2018; and

WHEREAS, the Department has amended the contract as noted above; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding was not anticipated when preparing the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 St Johns County Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, due to the state budgeting process, the Department has requested that the County expedite the process of executing contract amendments providing additional funding; and

WHEREAS, authorizing the County Administrator to execute contract amendments for the sole purpose of allocation of additional funding under the contract, subject to subsequent ratification and budgeting and appropriation of such funds by the Board of County Commissioners, will facilitate the provision of funding to the County by the Department.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY:

- Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby approves the terms, conditions, provisions and requirements of the 16th Amendment of the contract between the Florida Department of Children and Families and St. Johns County, Florida, and authorizes the County Administrator, or designee to execute the attached Amendment on behalf of St. Johns County and recognize unanticipated revenue of \$84,390.00.
- Section 3. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County authorizes the County Administrator, or his designee, to execute amendments to contract number NJ206 between the Florida Department of Children and Families and St. Johns County, provided that the sole purpose of such

amendment is the allocation of additional funding under the contract, and subject to subsequent ratification and budgeting and appropriation of such funds by the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 5. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

## CONTRACT BETWEEN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES AND ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

## **AMENDMENT #16**

THIS AMENDMENT, entered into between the State of Florida, Department of Children and Families, hereinafter referred to as the "Department" and St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the "Provider," amends Contract # NJ206.

Amendment # 16 incorporates the following: Attachment II-E - CBC Schedule of Funds for FY 2018 - 2019, dated on 7/1/2018 is deleted in its entirety; Attachment II-E - CBC Schedule of Funds for FY 2018 - 2019, dated on 11/30/2018 is inserted; increases State Fiscal Year 2018-2019 funding by \$41,851.00. Amendment #15 added the adoption incentive award of \$42,539.00, however it was not included in the fiscal year or contract total. This amendment incorporates both changes, thereby increasing the total contract amount to \$29,188,758.00, subject to the availability of funds.

- 1. Page 1, Standard Contract, Payment for Services, Section 3, is hereby amended to read:
  - 3. Payment for Services. The Department shall pay for contracted services performed by the Provider during the service performance period of this Contract according to the terms and conditions of this Contract of an amount not to exceed \$29,188,758.00 or the rate schedule, subject to the availability of funds and the Department's determination of satisfactory performance of all terms by the Provider. The State of Florida's performance and obligation to pay under this Contract is contingent upon an annual appropriation by the Legislature. Any costs or services paid for under any other contract or from any other sources are not eligible for payment under this Contract.
- 2. Page 33, Attachment I, Section 4, Method of Payment, Payment Clause 4.1, paragraph 4.1.1, is hereby amended to read:
  - 4.1.1. This is an advance fixed price, fixed payment contract comprised of Federal sources and a grant of state funds. Pursuant to section 409.1671(9), F.S., the method of payment provides for a 2-month advance payment at the beginning of each fiscal year and equal monthly payments thereafter. The Department shall pay the Lead Agency for the delivery of service units provided in accordance with the terms of this Contract for a total dollar amount not to exceed \$29,188,758.00, subject to the availability of funds. The Schedule of Funds is the document that identifies the amount of the Federal and grant sources. At the beginning of each fiscal year, the Schedule of Funds will be amended into this Contract, and the total contract amount will be adjusted accordingly.
