

RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 102



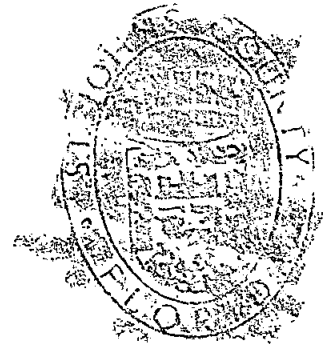
