

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-221

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 STATE HOUSING INITIATIVE PROGRAM (SHIP) FUND TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND TO AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE SHIP DEPARTMENT.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Fiscal Year 2020 operating budget was prepared prior to the final award amount for SHIP 2019-2020 funds; and

WHEREAS, in current Fiscal Year 2020 SHIP funding received additional funds in the amount of \$58,796; and

WHEREAS, the County must recognize and appropriate \$58,796 of unanticipated funds to enable its use; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY:

1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
2. The SHIP Fund revenue and expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$58,796.
3. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

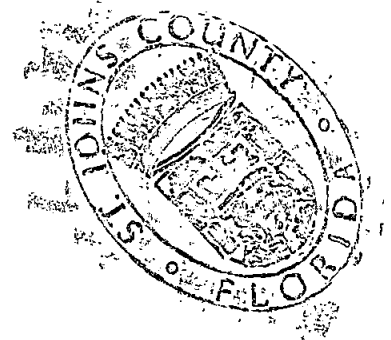
