## RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 230

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION SEEKING FUNDING ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY'S REBUILD FLORIDA CRITICAL FACILITY HARDENING PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF EMERGENCY GENERATORS FOR SEVEN (7) FIRE RESCUE STATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity has grant funds available to assist counties to harden critical infrastructure facilities; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Fire Rescue Department has identified the need for emergency generators at seven Fire Rescue Stations; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Recovery Department has reviewed the grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the Grant requirements, the County has determined that none of the requirements, restrictions, and/or obligations associated with award of the grant, or the grant itself, negatively impact the interests of the County; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the grant conditions and requirements, the County has determined that applying for the grant serves the overall interests of the County.

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

- **Section 1.** The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.
- Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves and authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to submit a completed application, on behalf of the St. Johns County Disaster Recovery and Fire Rescue Departments for a Florida Department of Economic Opportunity Rebuild Florida Critical Facility Hardening Program for funding emergency generators for fire rescue stations.
- **Section 3.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to execute any other paperwork necessary, and/or associated with the application for a Florida Department of Economic Opportunity Rebuild Florida Critical Hardening Facility program.

**Section 4.** To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
