

RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 340

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION SEEKING FUNDING ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY'S CDBG-DR REBUILD FLORIDA INFRASTRUCTURE REPAIR PROGRAM FOR THE HASTINGS DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity has Grant funds available to assist counties to increase resiliency and protect community lifelines and;

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Departments will identify projects which serve low income resident impacted by disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Recovery Department has reviewed the Grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, after a reviewing each of the Department's grant submissions, the Disaster Recovery Department will ensure none of the requirements, restrictions, and/or obligations associated with award of the Grant, or the Grant itself, negatively impact the interests of the County; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the Grant conditions and requirements, the County has determined that applying for the Grant serves the overall interests of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves and authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to submit a completed application, on behalf of the St. Johns County Disaster Recovery, and other specified departments for the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity CDBG-DR Rebuild Florida General Infrastructure Program Grant.

Section 3. The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator, or designee, to execute any other paperwork necessary, and/or associated with applications for the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity CDBG-DR Rebuild Florida General Infrastructure Program.

Section 4. To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
