WHEREAS, the additional funding was not anticipated when preparing the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 St Johns County Annual Budget.

Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County hereby ratifies the County Administrator's execution of the 24th Amendment of the contract between the Florida Department of Children and Families and St. Johns County, Florida, and recognize unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$518,187.00.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
