## RESOLUTION 2020-

## A RESOLUTION OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ESTABLISHING A RESERVE ACCOUNT FOR SURPLUS REVENUES OF THE CLERK OF COURT

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Court's office charges fees for services provided as set forth in Chapter 28, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, surplus funds received by the Clerk of Court through such fees revert to the County's general fund at the end of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Florida law does not permit the Clerk of Court's office to establish its own reserve fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it serves a County purpose to establish and maintain a restricted reserve account for the Clerk of Court's office,

**NOW THEREFORE,** be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County:

- 1. The above recitals are incorporated into the body of this resolution and are adopted as findings of fact.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners (the Board) hereby authorizes the establishment and maintenance of a restricted reserve account for the Clerk of the Circuit Court (the Reserve Account). The Board may allocate surplus funds received from the Clerk of the Circuit Court to the Reserve Account. However, nothing in this resolution shall obligate the Board to allocate funds to the Reserve Account in any given fiscal year.
- 3. Any expenditure of funds from the Reserve Account shall require the authorization of the Board of County Commissioners.
- 4. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
