A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO ACCEPT \$995,177 IN U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO SIGN THE FUNDING GRANT AGREEMENT; RECOGNIZING AND APPROPRIATING CDBG WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 GENERAL FUND BUDGET.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2020 the Board of County Commissioners approved the St. Johns County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fiscal Year 2020 Action Plan for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development reviewed and approved the 2020 Annual Action Plan and awarded St. Johns County \$995,177 to execute the projects specified in the 2020 Action Plan.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has made the Fiscal Year 2020 CDBG funds available to St. Johns County.

WHEREAS, the County did not anticipate receiving CDBG during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the County must recognize and appropriate CDBG of \$995,177 within the Fiscal Year 2021 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY:

- **Section 1.** The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the Chair to execute the attached Funding Grant Agreement (HUD -7082) on behalf of the County.
- **Section 3.** The Board of County Commissioners grants authority for the County Administrator or his designee to implement, manage, and administer the approved HUD CDBG Entitlement Program.

Section 4. The Board of County Commissioners recognizes that approved projects are subject to the availability of funds and environmental review approvals, and authorizes the County Administrator or his designee to adjust projects that do not rise to the level of a substantial amendment, as defined in the St. Johns County Citizen Participation Plan, and to provide additional information to HUD as may be required.

Section 5. The County Administrator or his designee is identified as the official representative of the Grantee to sign all appropriate sub-recipient agreements for the use of funds approved in the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan.

Section 6. The Board of County Commissioners recognizes and appropriates CDBG of \$995,177 to the Fiscal Year 2021 General Fund Budget..

Section 7. To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 8. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
