A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE TERMS, CONDITIONS, PROVISIONS, AND REQUIREMENTS OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE NORTH FLORIDA TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR A SPEED MANAGEMENT BY DESIGN STUDY FOR A1A/ANASTASIA BLVD; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON BEHALF OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY (COUNTY).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization has provided the County with a Memorandum of Understanding that provides for funding for a speed management by design study for the A1A/Anastasia Blvd. corridor from Red Cox Road to SR 312 in St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the Project will explore design concepts to enhance safety for all users of the corridor including pedestrians, bicyclist, and motorists; and

WHEREAS, the Project is in the best interest of the County for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:


Section 1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization and the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida.

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2021 between St. Johns County and the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization.

At the request of the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners, the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (North Florida TPO) is performing a Speed Management by Design Study for A1A/Anastasia Boulevard from Red Cox Road to SR 312. This study will explore design concepts to enhance safety for all users of the corridor including pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists.

The North Florida TPO general planning consultant, Atkins, will be providing professional services for the study for \$100,000. Compensation to Atkins for this work effort will come from the Unified Planning Work Program, the North Florida TPO's task based budget, which provides funding for studies such as this and from St. Johns County. This Memorandum of Understanding establishes the following:


1. The North Florida TPO will provide a total of \$50,000 from the Unified Planning Work Program with the remaining \$50,000 to be provided by St. Johns County.
2. Because Atkins is contracted by the North Florida TPO to do this study, St. Johns County will be invoiced by the North Florida TPO for its portion (\$50,000). Atkins will invoice the North Florida TPO for compensation for work completed.
3. Denise Bunnewith with the North Florida TPO will serve as project manager with assistance from Phong Nguyen, St. Johns County Transportation Development Manager.
4. The maximum indebtedness of the North Florida TPO will not exceed \$50,000 and the maximum indebtedness of St. Johns County, for its share of the project, will not exceed \$50,000.
